Handlers are limited to two dogs, regardless of owner, per open, novice and nursery class. No dogs will be able to run in both ranch and open. Please send a separate check for USBCHA Nursery entries.

The USBCHA Nursery Class will be run if minimum of 5 eligible dogs are entered. ***Please note the Ranch and USBCHA Nursery class will be run together. If you want to enter both ranch and Nursery, you will get one run. Fees for a dog entered in both Ranch and Nursery will be \$36 for the Ranch class plus an additional \$10 for the Nursery. Enter Dog in the Nursery section and write Ranch in the box. Send separate check (\$10) for Nursery.

Top 20 Open double-lift entries will be the top 20 combined open runs. No entry fee, no pay-out or ribbons. Running order will be drawn Sunday evening after the trial and posted in the tent area. Volunteers will be needed for set out.

Classes will be run according to the current NEBCA/USBCHA Guidelines.

All handlers are invited, at the end of the trial on Saturday, to join us for a catered Bar-B-Que dinner under the tent with Hatchland ice cream sundaes for desert. \$18 per adult, \$9 per child. Ice cream only -\$3 per person. Breakfast and lunch each day as well as dinners on Friday evening and Sunday evening are on your own. List of places to eat will be available at the trial.

In order for the trial to run smoothly, we will need the help of all handlers. Please volunteer for one of the following work areas: set-up of fencing, take down of fencing, sheep pen, setting out sheep, exhausting sheep, course changes, filling trial field water tub, announcing to the public, scribing for the judge and secretarial duties.

The trial field is our hay field. Please stay on the road across the field. Camping is perpendicular along the river, no hookups. Park your vehicle in front of your camper so that there will be plenty of room for everyone. When driving to your camping spot keep close to the campers to minimize your impact on our hay field. Camping stops at the pine trees on the north end as that part of the field is the course for Monday's open double lift. If you camp beyond there you will have to move Sunday after the trial. Handlers without campers will park straight ahead. Park perpendicular to the pine trees or the river. Do not park in the portable toilet area. No parking between the tent and the exhaust. Please take your trash home with you. Cell phones generally do not work on the trial field. Sometimes you can get reception at the barn, most people can get cell service up at the end of our driveway next to the road.

Rules and Regulations

1. There will be a limit of 2 dogs per handler at each level, regardless of ownership. No third dogs will be accepted. Please send a separate check for USBCHA Nursery dogs. Dogs may not run in ranch and open on the same day.
2. Entry fees: US Funds. Open class - \$54/dog; Novice and Pro-Novice - \$30/dog; Ranch - \$36/dog. USBCHA Nursery \$36/dog. Ranch/USBCHA Nursery \$46 – please send separate check (\$10) for the Nursery portion. Note dogs can run in Pro-novice and Nursery, but if they are running at the ranch level and nursery, you only get one run. Entries open April 18, 2017 and close June 17, 2017 or when limits have been met. No refunds after June 17, 2017. Running orders will be drawn by June 26th. Receipt of completed entry forms and fee constitute entry. No emailed entries will be accepted. Entry fee from cancelled entries will be torn up provided notification of cancellation is made before Sunday, June 18th.
3. Ribbons will be awarded in all classes (except USBCHA Nursery). The top 10 winners in the Open class will receive prize money.
4. Any damage done to the sheep by the dog, on or off the course, will be the responsibility of the handler.
5. Unsportsmanlike conduct and language on or off the trial field will not be tolerated.
6. Dogs will be under control at all times. Handlers are asked to clean up after their dogs. Poo bags and receptacles provided near the tent area.
7. No puppies will be displayed for sale.
